Statement of Policy:

Use of the Greenville Woodworkers Guild Inc. (the "Guild") facilities shall be solely for Guild sponsored activities and not to be rented or loaned to outside groups nor to Guild members for non-Guild sponsored activities.

Reason for Policy:

The Guild maintains the facilities for the benefit of the Guild and its' members for use in meeting the Guild's mission. The Guild is not interested in entering the facilities rental business, even though it might be a source of additional revenue.

Policy Requirements:

Facilities for the purpose of this policy will be defined as the following:

- Auditorium
- Woodworking shop
- Meeting rooms
- Classrooms
- Grounds
- Storage building
- Parking lot
- Any equipment contained in the building belonging to the Guild (lathes, saws and etc.).

Renting the Guild facilities for activities other than Guild sponsored activities would require adjustments to the building licensing, inspections, insurance, staffing and certain amenities such as restrooms, audio visual equipment, parking lot, cleaning services, liability disclaimers and etc.

Renting the Guild facilities would induce additional wear and tear to the facilities requiring more maintenance and repair than if the facilities are reserved for Guild sponsored activities.
